Diese Aufsätze geben zwar nur einen kleinen Ausschnitt aus dem Gesamtwerk von Parsons wieder. Dabei handelt es sich allerdings um den wichtigsten und grundlegendsten Teil, ohne dessen Kenntnis eine Beurteilung der Theorie Parsons' überhaupt nicht möglich ist. Diesem Band wird in Kiirze ein zweiter folgen, der einige Beitrage Parsons zur Theorie der Interaktionsmedien sowie einen Beitrag von Niklas Luhmann zu diesem Thema enthält (1). Die Herausgabe der beiden Bande zur Theorie der Sozialsysteme und der Theorie der Interaktionsmedien ist ein Versuch, die Auseinandersetzungen mit der gesellschaftlichen Systemtheorie (2) auf der Grundlagen ebene zu ergänzen.
