In May, 1890, Joseph Conrad sailed from the French sea-port of Bordeaux for the Congo, thus beginning what one of Conrad's biographers describes as "the most traumatic journey of his life." His experiences in the Congo had a profound effect on him. He himself said that these experiences had changed him for good. "Before the Congo I was just a mere animal"; he told a friend. What he saw in the Congo was subsequently recorded by him in Heart of Darkness, the most terrible of his short stories. (Heart of Darkness is something between a novel and a short story. It may be called a "novella"). To go through this brief masterpiece is a thrilling, frightening, and chastening experience for any sensitive reader; and every true student of literature is sensitive by training as well as by nature. Such pregnancy of language, such compactness of structure, such insight into the depths of human nature are hard to be found anywhere else in such an exquisite combination. As he travels to Africa and then up the Congo, Marlow encounters widespread inefficiency and brutality in the Company's stations. The native inhabitants

of the region have been forced into the Company's service, and they suffer terribly from overwork and ill treatment at the hands of the Company's agents. Heart of Darkness is a novella written by Polish-born writer Joseph Conrad (born Józef Teodor Konrad Korzeniowski). Before its 1902 publication, it appeared as a three-part series (1899) in Blackwood's Magazine. It is widely regarded as a significant work of English literature and part of the Western canon. This highly symbolic story is actually a story within a story, or frame narrative. It follows Marlow as he recounts, from dusk through to late night, his adventure into the Congo to a group of men aboard a ship anchored in the Thames Estuary. The story details an incident when Marlow, an Englishman, took a foreign assignment as a ferry-boat captain, employed by a Belgian trading company. Although the river is never specifically named, readers may assume it

Marlow is employed to transport ivory downriver; however, his more pressing assignment is to return Kurtz, another ivory trader, to civilization in a cover up.
