Und weil Chris Grabenstein den Erfinder erfunden hat, ist ein originelles, witziges Buch entstanden, das junge Leser durch Mitdenken 'und Mitraten von der ersten bis zur letzten Zeile in Atem hält. Kurz: ein Buch, das Lust am Lesen und an Büchern weckt. Kyle liebt Spiele, mit Büchern hat er es nicht so. Als er aber erfährt, dass der berühmteste Spiele-Erfinder die neue Stadtbibliothek gestaltet hat, will er unbedingt eine Einladung zur Eröffnungsnacht gewinnen, in der zwölf Zwölfjährige in der Bibliothek eingeschlossen werden.
